Management Structure

The West Moonah Community Shed has it's own coordinator who oversees the shed operations and safety.

The West Moonah Community Shed and House is managed by a Board of Management elected from its Voting Membership each year at the Annual General Meeting.

The Management Committee meets monthly to attend to the affairs of the Community Shed and House.

Staff are employed to undertake the day to day running of the Community Shed and House and the shed coordinator reports to the house manager who reports directly to the Management Committee.
